The removal of harassment and corruption will lead to more tax compliance

he recent move to unblock over 7,000 SIM cards following the submission of income tax returns is a welcome development in Pakistan's ongoing efforts to broaden its tax base. This innovative approach by the Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) has demonstrated that out-of-the-box solutions can yield tangible results, as evidenced by the filing of 7,167 new tax returns. However, while this initial success is commendable, the journey to bring a significant number of citizens into the tax net is far from over.

The FBR's strategy of leveraging mobile connectivity to enforce tax compliance is clever, yet it also underscores the need for deeper reforms within our tax system. The current cumbersome tax filing process must be streamlined to encourage voluntary compliance. One significant bar-

rier is the pervasive fear of harassment by tax authorities, which deters many from filing returns. To address this, the introduction of a fixed tax scheme with a no-questions-asked policy could be a game-changer. Such a scheme would reassure taxpayers that they will not be subjected to undue scrutiny or corrupt practices, potentially increasing compliance rates. Moreover,

the government must lead by example. If we are to instill a culture of tax compliance, it should be mandatory for every parliamentarian, officeholder, bureaucrat, and even non-civilians to file their taxes annually, including the rejection of zero returns when applicable. This would not only set a precedent but also build public trust in the tax system. And while blocking SIM cards has yielded positive results, sustainable progress will require comprehensive reforms. Simplifying the tax process and ensuring that all public officials lead by example are crucial steps. 
