

A New Low for Pakistan Cricket

n a stunning upset that has left Pakistani cricket fans in shock, Babar Azam's team managed to find a new way to embarrass themselves and the nation by losing to World Cup debutants, the USA. This historic low, even by Pakistan's de-plorable standards, exemplifies the catastrophic consequences of favoritism within the team.

The match in Dallas was a spectacle of missed opportunities and poor performance. Pakistan's top order crumbled early, with the team reduced to 26-3 inside five overs, thanks to a disciplined bowling attack led by the USA's Nosthush Kenjige and Saurabh Netravalkar. Despite a brief recovery by Babar Azam and Shadab Khan, who put on a 72run partnership, the Green Shirts never managed to dominate the game.

The USA, having set a modest target of 159-7, leveled the score to push the game into a super over, a scenario in which Pakistan's weaknesses were



brutally exposed. Naseem Shah's early breakthrough proved futile as the US batsmen, particularly Andries Gous and Monank Patel, comfortably kept the scoreboard ticking, showcasing a calm and calculated approach that was glaringly absent in the Pakistani camp.

In the super over, the USA set a challenging 19run target, which Pakistan failed to chase, managing only 13 runs. This defeat is not just a statistical embarrassment but a testament to the deep-rooted issues plaguing Pakistani cricket. Favoritism and poor selection policies continue to overshadow merit and performance, leading to such humiliating defeats.

The Pakistani cricket management must introspect and address these systemic flaws. The team's loss to the USA, a nation with significantly less cricketing history and infrastructure, underscores the urgent need for reform. Embracing meritocracy over favoritism could prevent such historic lows and restore pride in Pakistani cricket. Until then, the nation can only hope for a day when talent and performance dictate team selection, not favoritism and politics.
