





This negligence not only endangers lives but also emboldens perpetrators who operate with impunity.

The kidnapping of a Customs Officer among the abductees highlights that no one is immune from this terror. It is a call to action for law enforcement agencies and government officials to step up their efforts in safeguarding all citizens, irrespective of their ethnic background. There must be a concerted effort to ensure justice for the victims and to dismantle the networks that perpetuate these heinous

Ignoring these issues will only lead to further destabilization, not just in Balochistan but across the country. It is imperative for the government to recognize the gravity of this situation and to take immediate, concrete steps to rectors security and foster retional cohesion. restore security and foster national cohesion. 


