

olio continues to be a thorn in Pakistan's side, a olio continues to be a thorn in Paristan's side, a stark reminder of the country's struggle with preventable diseases. Despite substantial efforts, including those led by Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif and significant funding from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, the eradication of polio remains equisive. Every few months, new cases emerge, underscoring the inefficacy of current strategies and the persistent gaps in the nation's health infrastructure.

The involvement of global figures like Bill Gates often

turns into more of a photo opportunity than a harbinger of real change. Successive Pakistani prime ministers have posed with Gates, pledging to eliminate polio, yet the virus stubbornly persists. These high-profile meetings create headlines and perhaps a temporary boost in funding, but they fail to translate into sustained, on-the-ground improve-ments. The narrative remains the same: significant donor

funds flow into Pakistan, but the desired outcomes remain frustratingly out of reach

For the Gates Foundation and other international donors, Pakistan is a challenging partner. The recurring issues and lack of tangible progress make it seem like a perpetual cycle of hope and disappointment. While donors are keen to see Pakistan succeed, the country's inability to deliver consistent results despite decades of support makes it a global headache. global headache.

A critical factor behind this enduring struggle is the lack of genuine commitment and proactive measures from the government. The approach to polio eradication often appears half-hearted, with more focus on securing donor funding and managing the optics rather than addressing the root causes. Vaccine hesitancy, driven by misinformation and mistrust, remains widespread, and efforts to counter this are neither robust nor sustained. Moreover, the safety of polio workers, who face significant risks, is not adequately pri-

Without sincere efforts and a shift from superficial commitments to deep, systemic action, polio will remain a grim reality in Pakistan. It's a tragic irony that in an era when most of the world has eradicated this virus, Pakistan still grapples with it. The government must move beyond symbolic gestures and adopt a more determined, comprehensive approach to protect its children from this preventable disease. Only then can Pakistan bone to shed its polio burstill. disease. Only then can Pakistan hope to shed its polio bur-den and join the global community in declaring victory over


