The stark division between the ruling elite, represented by figures like Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif and PPP Chairman Bilawal Bhutto-Zardari, and the struggling populace is now more pro-nounced than ever. This budget has ignited a fire of discontent that is likely to fuel widespread un-rest and could very well signal the beginning of the end for this government. 


