

he recent revelation of domestic violence against Ayesha Jahanzaib, a well-known TV anchor, has shocked many, shedding light on a pervasive issue that transcends social status in Pakistan. Despite the glitz and glamour of her celebrity status, Ayesha's ordeal echoes the daily suffering of countless ordinary Pakistani women. According to media reports, Ayesha was subjected to brutal violence by her husband, Haris, who was arrested after allegedly

pointing a gun at her and throwing her out of the house. This incident is a stark reminder that domestic violence is not confined to any particular class or community. It is a widespread blight affecting affluent women, celebrities, and poor women alike. The brutalization of Ayesha Jahanzaib should serve as a catalyst for urgent action against this rampant issue.






