

he government's recent negotiations with the International Monetary Fund (IMF) to impose a tax on agricultural income reflect a broader issue plaguing Pakistan: a growing trust deficit between the government and its citizens. This trust deficit must be addressed before implementing any new taxes, as it significantly contributes to tax evasion.

History teaches us that there can be no taxation without representation. Citizens must feel represented and trust that their taxes are being used effectively and transparently. However, the controversy surrounding Form 47 has only deepened the public's mistrust. Many feel unrepresented and doubt the government's commitment to fair and equitable tax collection. This skepticism is particularly pronounced when new taxes are introduced, such as the proposed agricultural income tax.

The provincial governments' recent reassurances



to the IMF about implementing this tax are a step towards meeting the lender's demands. Yet, without addressing the underlying trust issues, these measures may fall short. The government's ambitious tax revenue target of Rs13 trillion, a significant increase from previous years, will likely place additional burdens on already taxed sectors, particularly salaried workers. This approach risks further alienating the public if they do not see improvements in governance and accountability

For meaningful progress, the government must prioritize rebuilding trust. This involves not only transparent and equitable tax policies but also gen-uine efforts to address the grievances highlighted by the Form 47 controversy. Ensuring that all sectors, including agriculture, are taxed fairly is crucial, but it must be accompanied by a commitment

to good governance and representation.
Ultimately, bridging the trust gap is essential for the government's financial strategies to succeed. Only then can the nation move forward with a unified approach to taxation, ensuring that all citizens feel represented and confident in their government's actions.


