## Inflation Rate Drop: A Mirage for the Common Man

rime Minister Shehbaz Sharif's recent announcement of Pakistan's inflation rate dropping to 9.6% in August 2024 may seem like a cause for celebration. However, for the average Pakistani struggling to make ends meet, this drop in inflation is far from a victory. The prime minister's satisfaction over these figures highlights a growing disconnect between the government and the reality faced by millions of citizens.

Inflation statistics, while technically accurate, often fail to reflect the lived experiences of the common man. A single-digit inflation rate does not erase the months or years of soaring prices that have already eroded the purchasing power of ordinary Pakistanis. Food, fuel, and essential commodities have become increasingly unaffordable, and the slight dip in inflation does lit-

tle to alleviate the financial burden that has accumulated over time. The reduction in inflation might ease the government's economic report cards, but it doesn't fill the empty plates on dinner tables across the nation.

Moreover, the government's focus on the inflation rate as a metric of success ignores the broader context of economic hardship. Unemployment remains high, wages stagnant, and the cost of living continues to rise. For those living paycheck to paycheck, a decrease in inflation offers little solace when their incomes have not kept pace with the cost of survival.

The reality is that a statistical drop in inflation does not translate into real relief for the common man. It is essential that the government not only acknowledges these figures but also addresses the systemic issues that keep the majority of Pakistanis trapped in a cycle of poverty and economic insecurity. Celebrating a modest drop in inflation without tackling these deeper problems is like offering a band-aid for a wound that requires stitches.




