

A History Of Broken Promises

he recent statement from the U.S. State Department, expressing a commitment to stand "shoulder to shoulder" with Pakistan in combating terrorism, might seem like a reassuring gesture to some. However, seasoned observers of U.S.-Pakistan relations know better. This is not the first time Washington has made grand promises of support, only to later withdraw when the geopolitical winds shift. For the current Pakistani government, the Biden administration's latest rhetoric should be a reminder that they've been

down this road before—repeatedly.

History is replete with instances where the U.S. has alternated between treating Pakistan as a critical ally and viewing it with suspicion. The relationship has often been characterized by a "hot and cold" dynamic, with periods of intense

cooperation followed by abrupt distancing. Pakistan's strategic location has made it a valuable partner for the U.S., but this partnership has rarely been one of equals. The U.S. has often prioritized its own interests, with little regard for the long-term stability or security of Pakistan.

The Biden administration, widely seen as a lame duck due to its dwindling domestic support and international credibility, offers little assurance that things will be different this time. While the State Department spokesperson's words may seem comforting in the face of rising terrorism, they ring hollow against the back-drop of history. Pakistan must approach this latest U.S. overture with caution and a clear-eyed understanding that Washington's promises have

often been as fleeting as they are fervent.
Ultimately, Pakistan's fight against terrorism is its own. The U.S. can offer words of support, but true security will come from withinthrough policies and partnerships that put Pakistan's interests first, not those of a faraway ally with a record of unreliability.


