# CJP Isa Joins Law Minister In Declining Extension Of **Tenure**

ISLAMABAD: After the federal law minister, Chief Justice of Pakistan (CJP) Qazi Faez Isa has confirmed that he does not wish to seek an extension in his tenure as the country's top judge. During an informal conversation with journalists in Islamabad on Monday, the chief justice said he was told in a meeting that the tenure of judges would be extended. 




