### A much needed and timely consensus on democratic norms

he unanimous resolution passed by the National Assembly to form a committee for addressing house-related issues in light of the recent arrests of PTI legislators is a welcome and timely move. This consensus comes as a breath of fresh air amid the heightened political tensions caused by the arrests within the confines of Parliament, allegedly by masked men. The disturbing incident, which violated the sanctity of the legisla-tive institution, has sparked widespread condemnation across party lines.

Speaker Ayaz Sadiq's stance on issuing production orders, and his emphasis on upholding the Parliament's dignity, reflects a much-needed commitment to maintaining democratic norms. His reminder that "two wrongs do not make a right" underlines the necessity of setting a

higher standard of governance, even in politically charged times. The suspension of security officials for their role in the arrests demonstrates that swift action has been taken to address the failure of parliamentary security.

Moreover, Defence Minister Khawaja Asif's

condemnation of the police and masked men's entry into Parliament as "shameful" reinforces the need to preserve the institution's sanctity. # **IHC To Review Imran's Request To Avoid Possible Military Detention**

ISLAMABAD: The Islamabad High Court (IHC) has scheduled a hearing on a petition filed by Pakistan Thereek-e-Insaf (PTI) founder Imran Khan, seeking to prevent his transfer to military custody.

The court's Registrar's Office set the petition for hearing despite objections, with Justice Miangul Hassan Aurangzeb presiding over the case on Thursday (tomorrow).



Imran Khan had filed the petition expressing concerns over a potential trial in a military court for the May 9 cases. The PIT founder argued that the Pakistan Army had already detained a retired officer (Gen Faiz Hameed), who could testify against him, raising the possibility of his trial under military law. Khan's legal team urged the court to ensure that he remains under the jurisdiction of civilian courts and not be handed over to the military. The petition cited the federal government, interior and defence ministries, Islamabai and Punjab police, and Adial alial authorities as respondents.
