



akistan's persistent reliance on borrowing, particularly from the IMF, has trapped the nation in a vicious cycle of debt. Instead of focusing on long-term solutions to its economic woes, successive governments have sought quick fixes, often at the expense of the country's fiscal sovereignty. The latest \$7 billion bailout from the IMF may provide temporary relief, but it does little to address the fundamental issues that plague the national econ-

Decades of IMF-dictated austerity measures have crippled Pakistan's ability to grow sustainably, leading to unprecedented levels of stagflation. Constant borrowing has led to a weakened economy where growth remains stagnant while inflation spirals out of control.

Each bailout delays the inevitable, with the government kicking the can down the road rather than implementing structural reforms that could revitalize the economy.

This reliance on external loans has burdened taxpayers, while those already in the tax net are further squeezed through minibudgets. Meanwhile, the government's inability to expand the tax base or stimulate exports reflects its short-sightedness. Instead of finding innovative ways to grow the economy, policymakers seem content with meeting IMF revenue targets through painful measures that hit the working class hardest.

The question Pakistan must now face is this: how long will the nation remain beholden to foreign lenders? Without a comprehensive, self-reliant economic strategy, Pakistan risks sinking deeper into the debt trap. It's time to break free from the IMF's cycle of loans and foster homegrown solutions to its economic crisis. Otherwise, this will surely not be the last bailout.


