For a nation where food prices have skyrocketed, and unemployment is rampant, the establishment of a new constitutional court or amendments to floor-crossing laws will do

nothing to alleviate the suffering of the masses. These political maneuvers, largely brokered by the ruling elites in closed-door

meetings, only serve their narrow self-interest. The common citizen, already shackled by economic despair, watches helplessly as the political class further distances itself from the core issues that truly matter—livelihood, security, and dignity.

This constitutional amendment saga, which includes the proposed abolition of the 19th Amendment and revisions in judicial appointments, is ultimately a power play, ensuring that the influential retain control. The draft, shared only with key political figures like Maulana Fazlur Rehman and Bilawal Bhutto Zardari, is emblematic of a system where decision-making is monopolized by a select

Until the political focus shifts from serving the elite to addressing the everyday hardships faced by millions, these amendments will remain nothing more than a distraction. The common man is left to ask-what real change do these political games bring to my life? The answer, unfortunately, is none.


