

Does anyone care about the declining health of democracy in Pakistan?

he recent refusal by local authorities to allow Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) to hold a public rally in Karachi under the pretext of security concerns raises serious questions about the health of democracy in Pakistan. Time and again, security threats are cited as a reason to suppress PTI's political activities, while other parties continue to function freely. The situation in Karachi, as heard by the Sindh High Court (SHC), paints a troubling picture of how selective security assessments are being used to curtail PTI's political freedoms.

Justice Yusuf Ali Saeed, in a pointed in-

quiry, questioned why only PTI faces such restrictions, while other political parties have been allowed to rally without issue. The fact

that the deputy commissioner East claimed that security clearance had not been granted without providing concrete evidence or explanation further deepens the concern. If security is such an overarching issue, a blanket ban on all political rallies, as suggested by the court, might seem more consistent. Yet,

only PTI's activities are being targeted.

A thriving democracy relies on a level playing field where all political parties are allowed to operate without fear or favor. PTI, like any other political entity, must have the freedom to engage with the public. Selective suppression of political activities, especially on dubious grounds, sets a dangerous precedent for future democratic processes in Pakistan. All political parties deserve equal rights to assembly and free expression, and no institution should hinder these essential democratic pillars in the name of security without clear justification.


