This issue, which has now been brushed off as a "misunderstanding" in a government inquiry, underscores the broader systemic negligence faced by artists in Pakistan.

The inquiry, ordered by the Sindh Culture Minister, reveals the disrespect and disregard often shown to those in the art world. Soomro's paintings were not only wrongfully withheld but also exhibited and rented


