

The Perils of Upper Sindh: A Haven for Banditry and Lawlessness

pper Sindh continues to spiral into an abyss of lawlessness, where banditry reigns unchecked and the rule of law remains a distant dream. The recent incident in Shikarpur, where eight individuals, including four women, were lured into a trap under the guise of a marriage proposal, starkly illustrates the state of extreme insecurity. This is not an isolated case but part of a long-standing pattern where the notorious katcha area has become synonymous with organized crime and violence.

Despite occasional operations by the po-

lice and Rangers, the situation has shown little improvement. Law enforcement's sporadic success, like the recent killing of a no-



torious bandit, does little to ease the daily fears of residents who remain at the mercy of these criminal networks. Tragically, even those tasked with restoring order, such as the 12 policemen martyred in Rahim Yar Khan, are regularly ambushed and outgunned.

Under these conditions, it's no wonder that investment in the region remains nonexistent. Who would want to live, let alone invest, in an environment where basic safety cannot be guaranteed? The plight of the common man, trapped in this cycle of violence and fear, is continuously ignored by the government and stakeholders who seem oblivious to the urgency of the situation.

It is high time that the authorities prioritize the restoration of law and order in Upper Sindh. Until then, the region will remain a no-go zone, abandoned by both its people and the prospects of development.




