It is imperative to recognize that this dangerous cycle of aggression and retaliation cannot be the solution to the deep-rooted issues plaguing the region. Violence only breeds more violence, leading to further devastation and suffering for countless civil-

Dialogue, no matter how difficult, remains

the only viable path to lasting peace. The international community must step forward, not to fan the flames of conflict by support-

Israel's actions, including assassinations of key figures and bombings, may be seen as strategic moves, but they ultimately undermine any possibility of reconciliation. that could engulf the entire region.

Both sides must show restraint and take meaningful steps towards de-escalation. Global powers, especially the United States and the United Kingdom, have a responsibility to temper their support and instead encourage genuine diplomatic efforts. The cost of war is too high, and without peaceful dialogue, this conflict threatens to spiral beyond control. Now is the time for calm heads and constructive conversations, not more violence and inflammatory rhetoric. Only through diplomacy can peace be achieved and stability restored in the region.



The statement follows the finance cara's earlier remarks regarding a "National Fiscal Benazir Income Support addressing Pakistan's external financing gap through the harmonisation of provincial ataxes and enhancement of revenue collection.

"We will sign the National Fiscal Pact with the provinces, which will help us address the external financing gap," he said last month.
