

This is not just a legal issue; it speaks to the unhealthy culture of dependency on individuals rather than institutions. Over the years, extensions have been

granted in various sectors, from the military to the judiciary, and each time, they have only postponed the resolution of underlying



structural issues. Such extensions prevent the healthy rotation of leadership and create an impression that certain individuals are indispensable, a dangerous notion in any democracy.Pakistan's myriad challenges - from political instability to economic crises - will not be solved by extending the influence of

any one person, no matter their capabilities Instead, these problems demand institutional strength, transparency, and accountability. A system that relies on the whims of individuals, rather than robust mechanisms, cannot hope to navigate these challenges effectively.If Pakistan is to move forward, it must end this practice. The country's future should not be held hostage to the personal decisions or influence of a few powerful figures. Justice Isa's decision not to seek an extension sets an example that should be followed across the board. The time has come for Pakistan to trust its institutions, not just its leaders.
