he recent remarks by Justice Mansoor Ali Shah about former Chief Justice Qazi Faez Isa have exposed deepseated fractures within the Supreme Court of Pakistan, signaling a crisis that can-not be ignored. Justice Shah's decision, along with five other justices, to skip the full court reference in honor of outgoing CJP Isa is a clear indication of discontent and division. In his letter, Justice Shah accused CJP Isa of fostering divisions, failing to defend judicial independence, and being indifferent to external pressures that threatened the judiciary's autonomy. Such strong words from a senior judge demand serious introspection, not just within

the judiciary but also by the new Chief Justice, Yahya Afridi, and the government.

The allegations raised by Justice Shah paint a



troubling picture of a judiciary divided, with claims of pettiness and administrative failures under CJP Isa's tenure. These concerns, cou-pled with the boycott of six judges, highlight a crisis of confidence that could erode the public's trust in the courts. It is imperative for the incoming Chief Justice to take proactive steps to heal these divisions, fostering a culture of unity, transparency, and meritocracy. The judiciary must not be allowed to become a battleground of individual egos and factionalism.

The government, too, must tread carefully. An independent judiciary is the cornerstone of democracy, and any attempts to undermine it will be detrimental to the rule of law. The new Chief Justice has a historic opportunity to re-store faith in the institution by building bridges, ensuring fair justice, and upholding the judiciary's independence without succumbing to external pressures. It is a moment that calls for courage, integrity, and leadership, qualities that will define the judiciary's future


