



he House of Sharif has once again unveiled its uncanny ability to blame everyone but itself, this time regarding Hasan Nawaz's bankruptcy declared by the High Court of Justice in London. The family's statement, brimming with familiar refrains, attributes this latest debacle to the nationalization policies of Zulfikar Ali Bhutto, the machinations of General Pervez Musharraf, and the rulings of former Chief Justice Saqib Nisar. Conveniently missing, however, is any acknowledgment of their own accountability or knowledgment of their own accountability or

mismanagement.

How long will this strategy of deflection endure? The Sharifs have perfected the art of spinning their financial disasters as political vendet-

tas. Yet, their claims of having suffered due to "unjust" actions fall flat when juxtaposed "unjust" actions fall flat when juxtaposed against their professed "astute business acu-

men," the supposed source of their opulent lifestyles. If their financial prowess was indeed so exceptional, why does bankruptcy keep shad-

owing their enterprises, now including Hasan Nawaz's UK company?

The narrative offered by the Sharifs is as transparent as it is tiresome. By shifting blame to external forces—be it governments, judiciary,

or historical policies—they sidestep any scrutiny of their practices. Is it arrogance, believing the public gullible enough to swallow their excuses? Or is it an almost magical Teflon quality that prevents anything—even the UK's legal declaration of bankruptcy—from sticking to their name?

This relentless cycle of denial must end. Pakistan's people deserve leaders who take responsibility for their failures, not just their successes. The Sharifs' ability to dodge accountability may have worked in the past, but the time has come for the public to see through their spin. If we continue to accept their excuses, we endorse a culture where power shields incompetence and evasion reigns supreme.


