

It sends a loud and clear message: the era of wasteful entitlements must end.

Pakistan, perpetually dependent on IMF bailouts, simply cannot afford the ridiculous expenses attached to such elite indulgences. The obsession with protocol—endless motorcades, bloated security details, and disruptive road closures—has long been a symbol of the gulf between rulers and the ruled. Worse, it diverts precious resources and manpower

This move deserves nationwide applause. It symbolizes not just austerity, but a reordering of priorities in favor of the people. If replicated across the government, it could mark the beginning of a new culture—one where leadership is defined not by the size of one's convoy, but by service to the nation.

The Supreme Court has set the standard. Now, Pakistan's rulers must follow.


