he shocking recovery of 18 children from a he shocking recovery of 18 children from a so-called orphanage in Chichawatni is not just another isolated case of brutality—it is a mirror reflecting the horrifying reality that Pakistan's children live with every single day. These innocent souls, many under ten years old, were allegedly beaten, tortured, and dehumanized in an unregistered "welfare" institution, while their tormentors operated freely under the nose of a sleeping system.

How many more viral videos will it take before the State wakes up? How many more Shahzads must endure beatings before Pakistan admits that child abuse is not the exception—it is the rule in a country where over 3,350 cases were reported just last year, and countless more remain buried in silence?

A nation that cannot protect its children has no fu-Anaton must decide today: will it remain a land where predators prey with impunity, or will it finally rise to defend its most vulnerable citizens? The cries of these children are not whispers—they are screams. The State must listen, act, and deliver
