



These are not just seasonal ailments anymore; they are evolving into poten-tial epidemics that could cripple an already burdened

healthcare system. Sindh's Health Minister Dr. Azra Fazal Pechuho has rightly launched a province-wide anti-dengue and malaria drive, mobilizing district health offices, local govern-ments, and Lady Health Workers to combat these vectorborne diseases.
