### The Doha Ceasefire Must Mark the End of Terror From Afghan Soil

t long last, reason seems to have prevailed. The announcement of a ceasefire between Pakistan and Afghanistan after 13 tense hours of negotiations in Doha offers a glimmer of hope in an otherwise dark chapter of cross-border hostility. Yet, this hope comes tempered with exhaustion — exhaustion born from years of betrayal, duplicity, and the repeated misuse of Afghan soil to export terrorism into Pakistan.

For too long, Pakistan extended goodwill,

hospitality, and brotherhood to its western neighbor — hosting millions of Afghan refugees, supporting reconstruction, and advocating global engagement with the Taliban

regime. In return, Pakistan has faced a relentless

wave of terrorist attacks, all traced back to sanctuaries across the border. This is not diplomacy; this is exploitation.

Today's ceasefire, confirmed by Qatar's Foreign Ministry and acknowledged by Pakistan's Defence Minister Khawaja Asif, must not become another fleeting handshake drowned in empty promises. It must be the final warning shot — a message loud and clear that Pakistan's patience has run out. The armed forces, the gov-

roment, and the people are united in one voice:
No more tolerance for terror.
The Taliban leadership must finally understand that peace with Pakistan is not optional—
it is existential. If this truce is honored, it could usher in true stability and cooperation between two Islamic nations bound by faith and geogra-phy. If violated, however, Pakistan must re-spond not with words, but with resolve. This ceasefire should mark not just the end of






