

rael's relentless push to annex the West Bank is a flagrant affront to international law and a dagger aimed at the fragile heart of Middle East peace. Every time there is a glimmer of hope—a cease-fire, a peace plan, or regional normalisation—Israel acts to undermine it, prioritizing territorial ambition over justice and stability. The recent preliminary approval of a bill to extend Israeli law over the occupied West Bank, despite global condemnation, is nothing short of a political provocation.

The United States, Israel's most powerful ally, now faces a crucial test. President Trump has clearly warned that annexation would cost Israel its vital US support, a stance echoed by Vice President JD Vance and Secretary of State Marco Rubio. This is not a mere suggestion; it is a moral and strategic imperative. Every delay,



equivocation, emboldens extremist elements in Israel and jeopardizes the precarious peace achieved in Gaza after years of brutal conflict.

The international community, led by Washington,

must act decisively. Annexation is not a domestic mat-ter; it threatens millions of Palestinians, destabilizes the region, and undermines every sincere effort toward reconciliation. Saudi Arabia, Indonesia, Turkey, and 13 other Muslim-majority nations have rightly condemned this move, and the United States must now transform words into action. The world cannot allow history to repeat itself. Israel's settlement expansion and annexation schemes are the mother of all illegalities, a blatant attempt to rewrite borders. with impunity. Enough is enough. The United States and its allies must put Israel firmly in its place, enforce international law, and safeguard place, enforce international law, and safeguard the dream of a viable Palestinian state. Peace is not optional—it is overdue, and it cannot survive while annexation remains on the table. This is a defining moment: either the world stands up to lawless ambition, or it resigns itself to a Middle East where hope is pernetually sabotaged petually sabotaged.


