



Within 30 minutes, he went from public adversary to effusive admirer, calling Mamdani a "great guy" and promising support rather than opposition.

From mocking female reporters as "Piggy to gushing over a mayor-elect he previously demonized, Trump's behavior is unparalleled. Observers were left both baffled and amused
