he latest brazen terrorist attack on the Federal Constabulary Headquarters in Peshawar — once again with unmistakable fingerprints pointing across the border — is not just another incident. It is the final warning shot in a long, painful pattern of violence bleeding into Pakistan from Taliban-run Afghanistan. The KP Police Chief's clear indication that the attackers were likely Afghan citizens only reinforces what Pakistanis have known for months: the so-called government in Kabul has become a permissive host, if not an active incubator, of terrorist

Monday's assault, which claimed the lives of three brave FC personnel and injured 12, showed how deeply entrenched and coordinated these networks have become. Investigators revealed that the assailants had no

Pakistani citizenship records, spent the night inside Peshawar before launching the attack, and arrived on a motorcycle now under forensic analysis. The swift response of the KP Police — killing two attackers before they could unleash mass carnage — deserves praise. But heroism alone cannot compensate for a failed re-

What is new today is not the violence — it is the rising fury of the Pakistani people. Public patience has

evaporated. The nation now sees the pattern with painful clarity terrorists slip in, strike soft and hard tar-gets alike, and melt back into the Afghan shadows under a regime either unwilling or incapable of reining

them in.

The world, too, has begun sounding the alarm. The UN Security Council, the EU, and multiple nations warn that the Taliban's growing rogue behavior threatens not only Pakistan but global stability. Islamabad cannot afford to vacillate any longer.

This is the moment for a decisive, all-or-nothing strategy. Pakistan must secure its borders, dismantle cross-border terror networks, and make it unmistakably clear that the era of one-sided restraint is over


